What is The Sparkle Box?

The Sparkle Box is a gift box for Jesus that you place under your Christmas tree and open on Christmas morning before you open any other gifts. You can decorate a box to make your own Sparkle Box, or you can purchase a gift box. Many “dollar” stores carry square foil boxes. The tradition is based on the picture book, *The Sparkle Box* written by Jill Hardie and illustrated by Christine Kornacki, which includes a Sparkle Box with the book.

What gifts go in The Sparkle Box?

Jesus wants us to love and take care of each other so any gift that helps someone in need is the perfect gift to give Jesus on his Birthday! Warm blankets, food for the hungry, and water filters are examples of gifts you can purchase in honor of Jesus. Write your gifts down and place them in your Sparkle Box.
